ADDITIONAL NOTES

THE DOGS REGULATION
(BY-LAW. 2016-572)

Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times in the Lac-Supérieur territory. Also, when you are on an unfenced property, you have to tie your dog up or keep it on a leash.

It is forbidden to let your dog barking, yapping, baying or bothering the neighbours. The latter will be considered as a nuisance if it damages private or public properties, terraces, lawn, gardens, flowers, shrubs or other plants, or if it chasing farm or domestic animals.

It is forbidden to not clean up regularly excrements on your property and to not maintain proper sanitary conditions. Furthermore, it is strongly recommended to not let your dog defecates on property other than yours excepted if the owner or the guardian of the dog takes appropriate measures to clean up immediately and properly the excrements and to dispose them cleanly and sanitarily.

THE NUISANCES BY-LAW (BY-LAW NO. 2013-534)

While it is good to meet up with friends around a campfire, a BBQ or to celebrate a special occasion, it is important to know that you cannot do everything on the Lac-Supérieur territory. Indeed, some municipal by-laws exist to keep a pleasant living environment and have the most harmonious living together. In regards to this, the principal by-law is the one on nuisances.

Here are the main points of this by-law that affect tourist residences and are important to respect.

First of all, you have to know that the owner of the property where the nuisances comes from have the same liability than the person who commits the nuisances, whether this person is a tenant or only authorized to access the property (art. 1.1). This means that not only the individual who is responsible of the nuisance will faces fines, but also the owner of where this one is from. Fines can be between a few hundred dollars to several thousand dollars, as much for natural than legal persons.

NOISE (CHAP. 2)

Causing noise nuisances is prohibited. To provoke or encourage in any way, noise that is susceptible of disturbing the peace, the tranquillity, comfort, peace and well-being of citizens or in any way prevent the peacefulness of the neighbouring properties is prohibited (art. 2.1).

Music

It is forbidden to play music and to install loud

speakers or amplifiers outside a building at all time.

Fireworks

Is considered a nuisance and is prohibited the use or allowing the use of firecrackers or fireworks (art. 2.5).

ARMS (CHAP. 3)

Is prohibited the use of firearms or compressed air firearms, bows or crossbows less than 150 metres from a house or a building (art. 3.1 and 3.2).

ANIMALS (CHAP. 4)

All animals howling or dogs barking which can disturb the peace and quiet of any person in the municipality is prohibited (art. 4.1).

Dangerous dogs

The owner or the guardian of an animal who fails to hold it or to keep it with a device preventing the animal to go outside his land, who let it stray in a public place or in another private property is forbidden (art. 4.2.3). For more details on dogs, see other section of this folder.

Wild and exotic animals

Keeping wild or exotic animals is prohibited. The fact of keeping, feeding or attracting one or more ducks, bustards, pigeons, gulls or seagulls on water bodies, private properties, in leaving or distributing food or food litter is forbidden (art. 4.3).

LIGHT, ODOUR, SMOKE AND BURNING (CHAP. 5)

Light

Lights directed beyond the property or lot on which it is installed and is susceptible of causing a public inconvenience to any citizen living on a neighbouring land (art.5.1).

Smells and smoke

The emission of nauseating odours or smoke, by means of or by using a product, substance, object or garbage, which could disturb the comfort or rest of citizens, or could trouble the neighbourhood constitutes a nuisance and is prohibited (art. 5.2).

Burning

Nauseating odours or smoke that travels due to burned materials which could disturb the comfort or rest of citizens, or could trouble the neighbourhood constitutes a nuisance and is prohibited (art. 5.3).

WASTE MATERIALS / DOMESTIC REFUSE (ART. 7.2)

Any domestic refuse brought to the curb for the collection service, but not in our list of accepted waste is prohibited (art. 7.2.1).

Dropping off household waste and recyclables elsewhere than in the bins provided by the municipality is forbidden (art. 7.2.2). Please make sure that the bins are completely closed after you drop off your waste because their odours could attract wildlife.
